# Kyoto Prefecture organizes an art festival "ALTERNATIVE KYOTO" in the prefecture.

## Art Festival "ALTERNATIVE KYOTO" in Kyoto Prefecture Imagination as a form of <capital>

Kyoto Prefecture has been developing art projects on subjects including the history, climate, tangible cultural properties, scenic spots, landscapes, rich nature, and the life and culture of areas of "Kyoto by the Sea (northern part of the Prefecture)", "Woodland Kyoto (middle part)" and "Kyoto Tea Country (southern part)". This year, Kyoto Prefecture will organize an art festival with the theme being centered on the possibilities that imaginative art possesses to change the coming society as a new form of capital. By creating a space with digital art that combines local culture with cutting-edge technology, and by displaying contemporary art works utilizing the artist-in-residence which disseminates local cultural resources, we will bring out the charm of local cultural resources to be promoted both in Japan and overseas. We will carry out this initiative that will aim to lead to an expansion of inbound tourism and the subsequent revitalization of the local economy.

## in Yosano/Kyoto by the Sea (northern part of the Prefecture)

The textile industry has been operational since ancient times, and Tango Chirimen, a high-class silk fabric, has supported and developed the regions in which it is made. Even now, the sound of weaving remains uninterrupted in Yosano Town. In Yosano, "Another Farm", a unit born from a collaboration between artists OZAKI Hiromi (Sputniko!) and KUSHINO Shinya, will present experimental art works that make full use of both traditional and latest technologies.
